

First Sunday of Lent





Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Lent is a time to remember and reflect on Christ's sacrifice and suffering, which He endured out of love for us. Sacrifice and suffering are closely connected. Without suffering, sacrifice loses its depth. In recent decades, our society has often seen pain and suffering as pointless. However, Christians

are called to embrace suffering for Christ, for the salvation of souls, and to connect with Jesus Christ's own sufferings. When we join our sufferings with Christ's on the cross, they gain profound value and purpose.

Choosing to give up something for Lent, like sweets, is a way to experience a small part of suffering. This act becomes a sacrifice that brings us closer to Christ. Lent without this element of sacrifice would feel lacking. Jesus faced betrayal and crucifixion for our salvation and out of love for us. Our Lenten practices don't need to be overly dramatic—Jesus Himself cautioned against this—but they should be heartfelt. This Lent, let's use our challenges and pains as pathways to grow closer to Jesus, to deepen our love for God and others, and, most importantly, to become more holy.




