## Father's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“But you shall say to them: Thus says the LORD GOD! And whether they heed or resist—for they are a rebellious house—they shall know that a prophet has been among them.”

When a Christian is baptized, we become three things: priest, prophet, and king. As a prophet, we are given the sacred task of proclaiming God's Word to the people similar to the prophets of the Old Testament. Practically, we can prophesy by how we treat others, what we say to others, and when we show forgiveness. Even though we may be prophets of Jesus Christ in the world, to our friends, families, co-workers or rivals by our words and actions, not everyone will listen.

We may feel disheartened because the people around us are resisting. However, we cannot control or force other people to listen. As much as we would like to see others come to Jesus Christ, a conversion in the heart must never be forced. If we invite someone to come to Mass who has not come for a long time and they insist on saying no, we cannot force them. Using force to bring someone to conversion shuts the door to a genuine relationship with Jesus and instead creates a shallow, artificial, empty practice of the faith while inciting bitterness and frustration. All we can do is invite. The rest depends on the Holy Spirit. Whether they heed or resist our call to come to Christ, in the end, they will know that a faithful and loving prophet is among them.

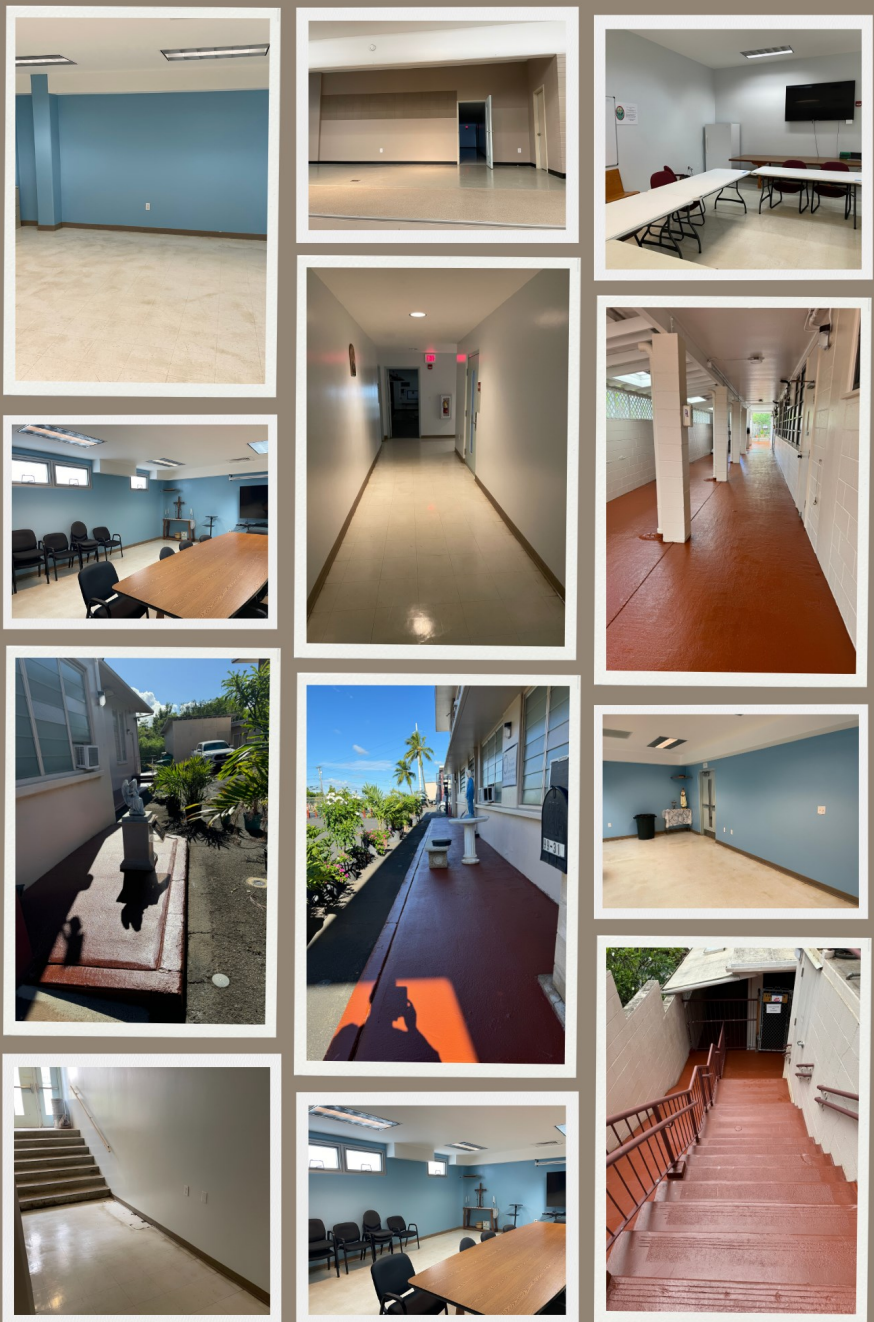
