## Father's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

### Through His Mercy, Christ Heals and Restores Us

Wishing everyone a Happy Sunday and many great blessings from God. Looking forward to seeing you all together with your family for the holy celebration of the Mass. On this 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday, the church continues to remind us that Jesus is a friend of all. So, He is willing to do the unimaginable to save us. Hence, the church calls us to make Jesus our role model by caring for the sick.

Our first reading and gospel have a lot in common. Both referred to the hopeless situation caused by leprosy. In Jesus's time, leprosy was a dreaded disease and Contacting leprosy was a matter of life and death. Though it was a physical sickness, according to Jewish religious beliefs leprosy was broadly associated with sin. That is, leprosy was a punishment for a sin committed by its victim.

Today, He encountered a leper. Instead of avoiding or stigmatizing the leper, he touched and healed him. The humble petition of the leper touched him: "If you want, you can cure me." As a compassionate savior and master, Jesus responded with both words and actions: "Of course, I want to be cured!"

How should we treat the sick, the weak, the poor, and those rejected by society? We must show them mercy and help them as Jesus did. Through his mercy and compassion, Jesus is always ready to free us from whatever makes us unclean. Therefore, let us praise him and be another Christ to care for our sick and needy brothers and sisters in our family and society.
