## Father's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"The Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power." This is the responsorial psalm we will sing this coming Sunday. It prompts us to wonder: Has the Lord truly shown His saving power to all nations? Specifically, why didn't Jesus reveal His resurrection to the entire world? Why only to His disciples? Abbot Jeremy Driscoll, a Benedictine monk, once asked, why didn't Jesus appear to the Emperor of Rome and announce, "Surprise!"

The answer lies in the very nature of our faith. Indeed, God could have made the resurrection of His Son unmistakably clear to everyone on earth, eliminating any doubt. However, He chose a more subtle approach. This decision underscores the importance of faith and free will in Christianity. If the resurrection was an undeniable fact known to all, we wouldn't have the chance to live out our faith, to be Christ's representatives on earth, and to spread the Gospel through our actions and words.

By revealing Himself only to a select few, Jesus invites us to respond to His call to "love one another as I love you." The Gospel reminds us, "It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain." This mission would be meaningless if Jesus had made a grand, undeniable entrance to the whole world post-resurrection.

Thus, we are given the profound responsibility and privilege to be living examples of Jesus Christ. Through our actions, words, and lives, we become the instruments through which the Lord reveals His saving power to the nations.
