Father's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Out of the three Divine Persons of the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit is often the most overlooked. Many of the faithful have no difficulty praying to the Father or the Son because these two Persons feel more tangible. When we think of the Father, we envision a loving parent. When we think of the Son, we see Jesus as a concrete Person. But the Holy Spirit can seem more abstract, making it harder for us to relate.

This Pentecost, we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit, the promised Advocate, upon the apostles. This same Spirit hovered over the waters during the creation of the universe in Genesis and appears throughout the Old Testament. We see the Spirit descending upon individuals, giving them strength, courage, wisdom, and the renewal of their hearts and minds. Similarly, those receiving Confirmation are "sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" to be wise, strong, and brave in their Christian faith.

We should turn to the Holy Spirit more often, asking for the strength to be courageous in professing and living out the Christian faith, especially when faced with mockery, insults, and persecution. This week, let's make a special effort to pray to the Holy Spirit, asking for the zeal and passion we need to fulfill our obligations and commitments. In doing so, we help build up the kingdom of God in our community.

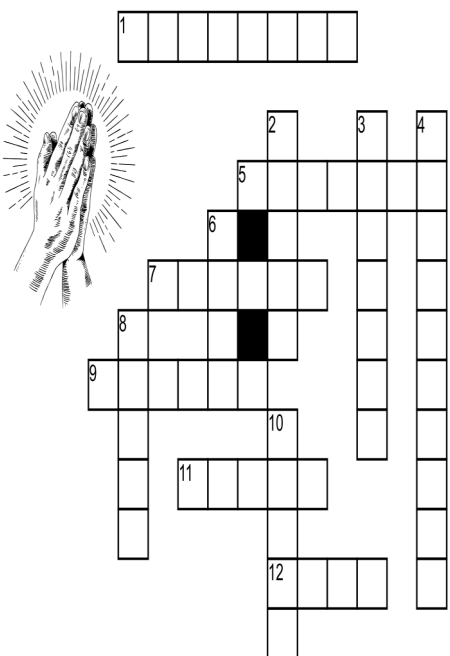
