Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil."

This brief Scripture passage from St. Paul this week can make us feel a mixture of emotions. Paul tells us that all of us will eventually appear before "judgement." Naturally, we might be afraid of judgement because we know that all of us make mistakes and the wrong choices from time to time. That is why, through God's grace, we try our best to avoid falling into sin. God is both a God of justice and a God of mercy,

With so much turmoil in the world, we take confidence knowing that the Lord will deal according to what a person does, whether good or evil. At the same time, we know that we will face judgement ourselves for our actions. We are naturally quick to jump to conclusions about the mistakes, wrong doings, faults, and sins of others but we must also remember that we are not perfect. Who knows what judgement awaits us when we go before the King of Kings?

To avoid a sense of pride and self-righteousness, we must be realistic and humble. Realistic in a sense that we know our own sins, faults, and failings. We must also be humble, accepting that we are in fact, broken human beings in need of God's mercy and grace. This attitude forms our hearts and souls to be more patient, kinder, and merciful towards ourselves and towards others.

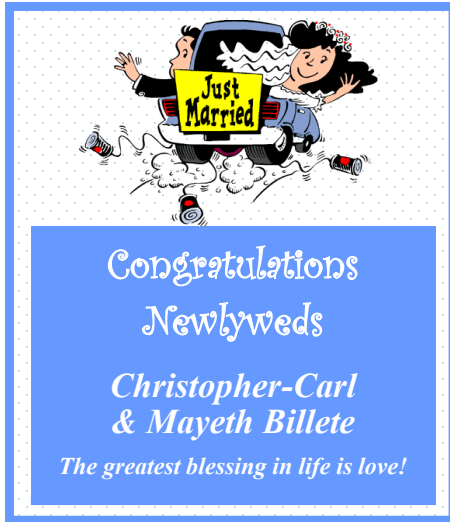
