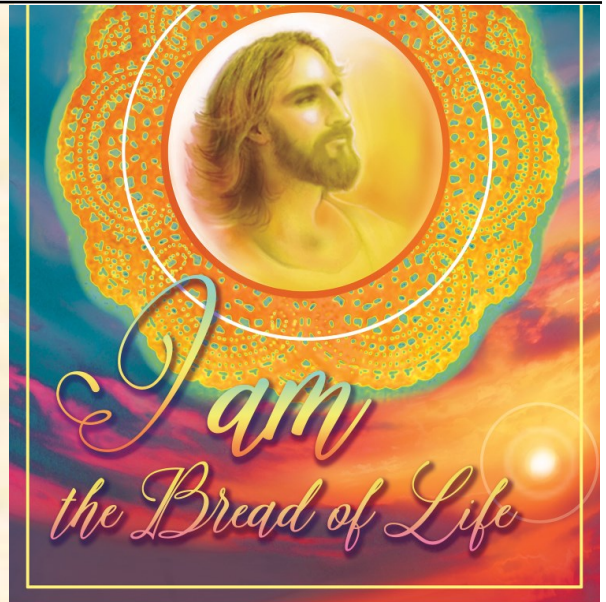

Father's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

The first reading from Exodus this week echoes one of my favorite Psalms: "Hear my voice O God as I complain." The Lord rescues Israel from slavery in Egypt and the moment things become difficult, the Israelites complain. As if that was not enough, the Israelites say that they would rather die in slavery rather than starve in the Lord's care in the desert. Of course, the Lord could teach the Israelites a lesson in thankfulness and gratitude, but He chooses not to. Instead, the Lord hears their complaints and gives the people the food they so desperately desire.

We complain all the time. Every inconvenience, every hardship, or a person we don't like naturally makes us want to complain about it. This is normal and sometimes we do need to complain to friends. However, the saying is true that complaining never solves anything. Instead of voicing problems and complaining about them, we can take it a step further by acting on it. Perhaps that means taking the initiative in doing something that needs to be done or changing our ways and action rather than telling someone else to change. When we dedicate more time to action guided by the Holy Spirit, we will find ourselves complaining less and trusting in God's ability to provide for us.
