Father's Message



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

"Restore our fortunes, O LORD, like the torrents in the southern desert. Those that sow in tears shall reap rejoicing. Although they go forth weeping, carrying the seed to be sown, They shall come back rejoicing, carrying their sheaves."

Psalm 126 this Sunday is a reflection of the hardship of Christian life. While the yoke of Christ is easy and light, the reality of life is not. We all must face suffering, penance, and struggle in one way or another. These hardships are seeds that we sow with our tears and while we go forth weeping, those hardships will ultimately plant the seeds for rejoicing. We can sum this up to another saying we may have heard before "what does not kill you makes you stronger." In this case, hardship and struggle, when embraced just as Jesus embraced His cross, makes us stronger in virtue.

The writer of Psalm 126 uses the word "sheaves," symbolizing our ultimate return to God with abundant joy. All of us must take up our own crosses. When we take up our crosses and follow Jesus through the hardship, we too will come back rejoicing, carrying our sheaves unto eternal life in Heaven.

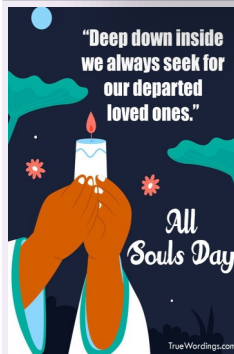
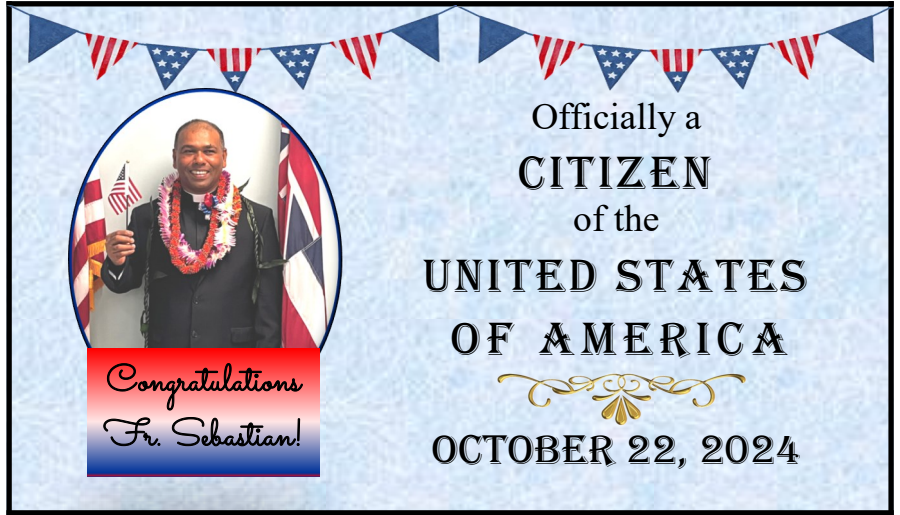

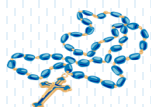
