Father's Message



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This past Saturday, the Catholic Church celebrated the dedication of the Basilica of Saint John Lateran. Originally consecrated in 324 AD and completed in 1735, this basilica stands as a stunning testament to the splendor of Baroque architecture and the richness of our Catholic faith. The use of gold, marble, and other precious materials in its construction might raise questions about the Church's priorities. Why should we build such magnificent structures when these resources could be used elsewhere?

To understand this, think of someone you love dearly. When you want to express your love with a gift, a simple five-dollar Walmart gift card probably doesn't seem adequate. Instead, you'd want to choose something meaningful and special, something that truly shows the depth of your affection. You might even spend more time and money to select that perfect gift because love calls for a generous and heartfelt response.

In the same way, faithful Christians, inspired by a profound love and reverence for God, have long desired to give Him their very best. Building a temple of noble materials is one way to express this love and honor His glory and majesty. While it's true that the money used for such projects could have gone to feeding the poor, Jesus reminds us, "You always have the poor with you, but you will not always have me." Building a house of worship for God's glory is a singular act, and as history has shown, these sacred spaces endure, pointing us toward the eternal presence of God.

So, the next time we see a beautiful cathedral, intricate vestments, or ornate chalices, rather than questioning why the Church spent money on such items, let's reflect on the deeper meaning. These offerings are signs of love—love for God that invites us not only to give from our wealth but to give our whole hearts and souls.

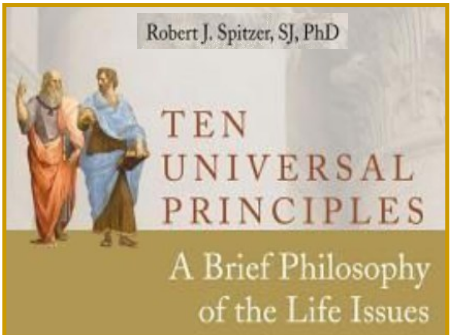
