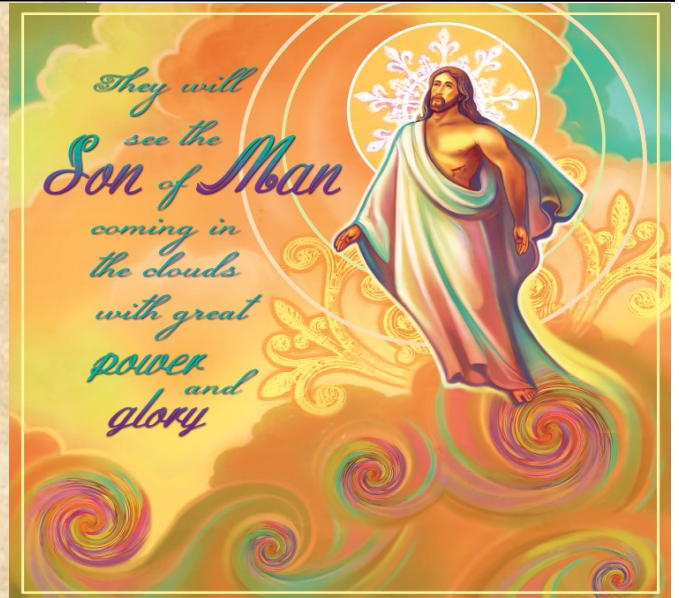

Father's Message



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Eternal Perfection in Christ

Aloha. Wishing everyone a Happy Week with God's blessing of love and happiness. God loves us very deeply and lets us love Him and love one another. On this thirty-third Sunday, we celebrate the final consummation at the end of time. The readings of this Sunday are set in a prophetic tone. In other words, they point to God's people's future deliverance through Christ's redemptive work.

The readings also remind us of the glorious seasons that are ahead of us. Most importantly, this Sunday, the holy mother church raises our hope of salvation by reminding us of our future and eternal perfection through Christ's single sacrifice.

In the gospel, Jesus employed different natural causes to remind us of the need to be on guard for his great coming. The tone of his message moves from the prophecy of the great tribulation to the prophecy of the coming of the Son of man.

Hence, the central point of Christ's message is that no one knows when this time or moment will be. We need to be alert and watchful with holiness and goodness. This reading equally reminds us that Christ is a prophet, as well as our savior. By saying that: "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my word will not pass away unfulfilled," Christ wishes to remind us that his coming and our salvation is sure.

He invites us to be prepared for the new kingdom that He wishes to establish, kingdom of peace and kingdom of love. So, with confidence in the Lord who is to come, let us joyfully proclaim with the Psalmist: "You are my inheritance, O Lord."
